**Attendees:** PMA member companies, prospective member companies, press, consultants, academics, former members and spouses/companions are welcome to attend.

On December 30, 2021 a wildfire raged through Boulder County, Colorado, driven by winds over 100 mph. More than 1,000 homes were destroyed including the 2,300 sq. ft. building on the Demarest property that housed Cerulean Technologies, Chuck's one-man consulting/testing/prototyping company. Nothing survived. The fire was named the Marshall Fire, and it ignited about two hundred yards to the west of his location in Marshall. Chuck will present a recount of this event focusing on before, during, and after this disaster.


